

BOB CABARET: LOCAL PRODUCTION IN SINTRA

BOB Cabaret is a project by Irene Alvarez & Marlene Jöbstl, born from the desire of creating a cabaret show in collaboration.

Quinta Ten Chi served as the creative hub and venue for the show's premiere.

BOB Cabaret was conceived during the BOB Festival, a weeklong event dedicated to scenic creation, produced by Irene, led by Marlene and held at Quinta Ten Chi from June 23rd to 30th, 2024.

The festival generated a pedagogical space that fostered the creative freedom of each individual.

The seed of BOB Cabaret was planted there, and the show evolves as various artists contribute with their talents.

The fundamental question that serves as the starting point and pillar for participation in BOB is:

"What is beauty for you?"

by artists in the wild setting of Sintra. Quinta Ten Chi, a place where earth and sky meet in the heart, provided the technical and logistical support necessary to bring BOB to life as a show that is now prepared to travel throughout Portugal and beyond.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

LIGHTS

2 blue spotlights

1 red spotlight

1 white spotlight

We can bring our own spotlights

SOUND

Sound system with a mini jack input

STAGE

Dimension: minimum 5 meters wide, 4 meters deep.

We create our own backstage on stage.

Therefor we need to tense a light rope from left to right to hang our background sheet. One simple hook like a nail or screw on each side of the stage will do.

*We bring our own sound and light operator.
